Booking an appointment on ActiveNet

Last updated: April 14, 2021

In York Region, COVID-19 vaccinations clinics are offered through a partnership between York Region Public Health, our local hospitals and community partners. Different bookings systems are used to support booking appointments for COVID-19 vaccinations.

To book an appointment at a **York Region Public Health** COVID-19 vaccination clinic, you must use an online system called ActiveNet. Booking a vaccine appointment on ActiveNet is a **two-step process**.

You must first set up an account and then book an appointment.

STEP ONE

- To book an appointment, visit york.ca/COVID19Vaccine
- Select the eligible priority group you wish to book an appointment for from the blue list on the page; click the white arrow on the right side to view the drop-down menu for that group

Note: Eligible groups are updated frequently and do not appear in the example below for that reason. All current eligible groups will be clearly viewable online at york.ca/COVID19Vaccine

- In the drop-down menu, you will see the full eligibility list and the clinic locations serving those groups
- Select the blue **'Book an appointment'** button on the location of your choice

- All COVID-19 vaccines provide sustained, substantial protection **approximately 14 days** following the first dose
- Even after receiving a vaccine, please continue to follow public health measures to keep everyone safe and healthy: Avoid social gatherings, stay home if unwell, practice physical distancing, wear a mask when required and wash your hands frequently
