Community Living York South is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors elected at the Annual General Meeting. **Our Annual General Meeting is scheduled virtually for September 22, 2022.**

This is a call for nominations to fill existing Board vacancies at this meeting. Our Board members include advocates, parents and other residents of Southern York Region.

The Nominating Committee is particularly interested in candidates with experience and skills in financial management and those who hold professional designations in accounting. Previous Board experience, familiarity with and interest in the developmental sector are assets. We are strongly encouraging applicants from diverse communities to apply. Board members are elected to a three-year term and are expected to attend eight to ten Board meetings per year. All Board members are also expected to sit on a Board committee with a further commitment of four to six meetings per year.

Priority will be given to those candidates residing and/or working in York Region due to funding requirements.

Interested individuals may submit their candidacy or nominate others to the Board by submitting **an expression of interest**. The expression of interest should include a resume and letter outlining your interest and relevant competencies.
